Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP10101 – Understanding Diversity in Higher Education Classrooms	This module explores diversity in academic preparation, learning preferences, language background, disability, and socio-cultural experience. Faculty learn how diversity affects participation and achievement. Inclusion is framed as design, not remediation.		
SP10102 – Principles of Universal Design for Learning	Focuses on the three core UDL principles: multiple means of engagement, representation, and expression. Faculty learn how UDL reduces barriers proactively. UDL is positioned as a planning framework, not an accommodation checklist.		
SP10103 – Designing Accessible Learning Materials and Instruction	Explores strategies to make lectures, readings, slides, and digital resources accessible. Faculty learn how clarity, structure, and multiple formats support all learners. Accessibility is aligned with academic quality.		
SP10104 – Inclusive Classroom Interaction and Participation	Examines how classroom norms, discussion formats, and assessment practices influence inclusion. Faculty learn strategies to encourage participation without forcing disclosure or performance. Psychological safety and intellectual challenge are balanced.		
SP10105 – Inclusive Assessment and Flexible Demonstration of Learning	Focuses on assessment design that allows students to demonstrate learning in varied ways while meeting standards. Faculty learn how to maintain fairness and rigor. Transparency and alignment are emphasised.		
SP10106 – Implementing UDL Without Increasing Faculty Workload	Explores practical ways to adopt inclusive practices sustainably. Faculty learn how small design shifts create significant impact. Efficiency and long-term feasibility are prioritised.
