<b>SP10601 – Understanding Employability in Higher Education Contexts</b>	This module explores what employability means beyond immediate job placement. Faculty learn how critical thinking, communication, adaptability, and ethical reasoning underpin career readiness. Long-term skill development is emphasised.		
<b>SP10602 – Mapping Academic Learning to Industry-Relevant Skills</b>	Focuses on identifying transferable skills embedded within disciplinary content. Faculty learn how to make skill development explicit without diluting academic depth. Alignment rather than replacement is prioritised.		
<b>SP10603 – Designing Assessments that Reflect Real-World Application</b>	Explores assessment formats that simulate professional tasks such as projects, case analyses, and presentations. Faculty learn how to maintain academic standards while enhancing relevance. Authenticity is emphasised.		
<b>SP10604 – Integrating Career Conversations into Teaching and Mentoring</b>	Focuses on how faculty can discuss career pathways within academic contexts. Participants learn how to guide exploration without prescribing outcomes. Student autonomy is prioritised.		
<b>SP10605 – Collaboration with Industry and External Stakeholders</b>	Examines partnerships with industry, alumni, and professional bodies. Faculty learn how to leverage guest lectures, projects, and internships ethically. Mutual benefit and academic integrity are emphasised.		
<b>SP10606 – Preparing Students for Transition to Work and Lifelong Learning</b>	Explores how to support students' transition from university to professional life. Faculty learn strategies to build confidence, adaptability, and reflective capacity. Future readiness is framed as an ongoing process.
