Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP2501 – Language Development in Primary School Children	This module explores how vocabulary, sentence structure, and comprehension develop during the primary years. Teachers learn what language skills are expected at different ages. Classroom implications for instruction and communication are discussed.		
SP2502 – Teaching Reading Beyond Decoding	Focuses on helping children understand meaning rather than only reading words. Teachers learn strategies for building comprehension, inference, and critical thinking. The limitations of mechanical reading practices are examined.		
SP2503 – Supporting Writing as a Developmental Process	Explains writing as a gradual skill involving planning, expression, and revision. Teachers learn how to support writing without excessive correction. Confidence and clarity are prioritised over perfection.		
SP2504 – Strengthening Listening and Speaking Skills	Explores oral language development through discussion, storytelling, and presentation. Teachers learn strategies to encourage participation and respectful listening. Classroom dialogue is strengthened.		
SP2505 – Supporting Struggling Readers and Writers	Introduces inclusive strategies for children who face literacy challenges. Teachers learn how to scaffold learning without labelling or comparison. Sensitivity and consistency are emphasised.		
SP2506 – Creating a Language-Rich Classroom Environment	Focuses on classroom routines, displays, and teacher talk that support language growth. Teachers learn how everyday interactions build literacy. The environment is treated as a learning tool.
