Learning Objective : This course equips primary school teachers with the knowledge and practical strategies to build classroom environments that are inclusive, respectful, and emotionally safe for all learners. Teachers learn how classroom culture influences behaviour, learning, peer relationships, and well-being, and how to actively foster belonging, fairness, and mutual respect in Grades 1–5.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP3001 – Understanding Classroom Culture in Primary Education	This module explains what classroom culture is and how it forms through daily interactions, routines, and expectations. Teachers learn how their beliefs, language, and responses shape classroom climate. The impact of positive versus negative culture on learning is explored.		
SP3002 – Teaching Respect, Empathy, and Kindness	Focuses on how respect and empathy develop in middle childhood. Teachers learn classroom practices that encourage kindness, perspective-taking, and cooperative behaviour. Modelling respectful behaviour is emphasised.		
SP3003 – Addressing Bias, Fairness, and Inclusion	Examines conscious and unconscious bias in classroom practices. Teachers learn how perceptions of fairness affect student trust and behaviour. Strategies to promote equitable treatment are discussed.		
SP3004 – Preventing and Responding to Bullying and Exclusion	Explores early signs of bullying, teasing, and social exclusion. Teachers learn preventive strategies and appropriate responses that protect dignity and safety. A whole-class approach is emphasised.		
SP3005 – Encouraging Student Voice, Belonging, and Participation	Focuses on helping every child feel heard and valued. Teachers learn ways to encourage participation without pressure. Classroom belonging is linked to motivation and engagement.		
SP3006 – Sustaining a Positive and Respectful Classroom Culture	Emphasises consistency, reflection, and long-term commitment to positive culture. Teachers learn how to reinforce values through routines and responses. Culture is presented as an ongoing process rather than a one-time effort.
