Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP3301 – How Early Adolescents Learn Differently	This module explores changes in thinking, attention, and reasoning during early adolescence. Teachers learn why students question explanations and seek relevance. Teaching implications for instruction and pacing are discussed.		
SP3302 – Designing Developmentally Appropriate Lessons	Focuses on lesson structure, pacing, and relevance for Grades 6–8. Teachers learn how to balance curriculum demands with adolescent attention and motivation. Engagement is prioritised without sacrificing rigour.		
SP3303 – Encouraging Active Learning and Participation	Explores strategies that move students from passive listening to active engagement. Teachers learn discussion, inquiry, and collaborative learning techniques suitable for adolescents. Student voice is encouraged within structure.		
SP3304 – Teaching for Thinking and Conceptual Understanding	Focuses on moving beyond memorisation to reasoning and application. Teachers learn strategies that promote analysis, questioning, and problem-solving. Depth of understanding is emphasised.		
SP3305 – Managing Resistance and Disengagement in Learning	Explores common forms of academic resistance in middle school. Teachers learn how to interpret disengagement developmentally. Strategies for re-engaging students are discussed.		
SP3306 – Reflective Teaching for Adolescent Classrooms	Encourages teachers to reflect on lesson effectiveness and student response. Teachers learn how to adapt strategies based on classroom realities. Reflection is framed as professional growth.
