Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP3401 – Understanding Motivation in Early Adolescence	This module explores intrinsic and extrinsic motivation during ages 11–14. Teachers learn why rewards and punishment lose effectiveness at this stage. The role of autonomy, relevance, and peer influence is examined.		
SP3402 – Causes of Disengagement and Apathy in Middle School	Focuses on common reasons students withdraw or resist participation. Teachers learn how academic pressure, fear of embarrassment, and identity concerns affect engagement. Developmental explanations are prioritised.		
SP3403 – Designing Engaging and Relevant Learning Experiences	Explores how lesson relevance, real-world connection, and choice increase motivation. Teachers learn strategies to make content meaningful without reducing academic expectations. Practical classroom examples are discussed.		
SP3404 – Encouraging Participation Without Forcing Compliance	Focuses on respectful participation strategies that avoid public pressure. Teachers learn how to invite engagement through structure and safety. The impact of peer dynamics on participation is addressed.		
SP3405 – Supporting Low-Motivation and Withdrawn Students	Introduces strategies for re-engaging students who appear disconnected or discouraged. Teachers learn how to build confidence gradually. Relationship-based motivation is emphasised.		
SP3406 – Sustaining Motivation Over Time	Examines how motivation changes across the school year. Teachers learn strategies to maintain engagement during academic fatigue periods. Balance between encouragement and accountability is highlighted
