Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions
SP3801 – Understanding Underperformance in Middle School	This module explores why students who performed well earlier may begin to struggle in middle school. Teachers examine academic load, developmental changes, emotional factors, and teaching–learning mismatches. Underperformance is viewed as situational rather than fixed ability.
SP3802 – Identifying Learning Gaps and Skill Breakdowns	Focuses on recognising gaps in foundational skills such as reading comprehension, writing structure, numeracy, and study habits. Teachers learn to identify patterns through classwork and observation rather than tests alone. Sensitivity and confidentiality are emphasised.
SP3803 – Classroom-Based Academic Support Strategies	Introduces practical strategies that can be implemented within regular lessons. Teachers learn how to scaffold instruction, break tasks into manageable steps, and reinforce key concepts. Support is integrated, not segregated.
SP3804 – Addressing Motivation, Avoidance, and Learned Helplessness	Explores how repeated difficulty leads to avoidance, low effort, or resignation. Teachers learn strategies to rebuild motivation and agency. Emphasis is placed on effort, progress, and realistic goal setting.
SP3805 – Working Constructively with Parents of Underperforming Students	Guides teachers in communicating academic concerns with clarity and empathy. Teachers learn how to shift conversations from blame to partnership. Aligning school and home support is prioritised.
SP3806 – Preventing Long-Term Academic and Emotional Consequences	Focuses on early, consistent intervention to prevent dropout, disengagement, or chronic failure. Teachers learn how monitoring progress and timely adjustments make a long-term difference. Sustainability is emphasised.
