**Learning Objective :** This course strengthens middle school teachers’ communication skills to support clarity, authority, engagement, and respectful relationships with students aged 11–14. Teachers learn how verbal and non-verbal communication, listening, questioning, and conflict communication directly influence behaviour, motivation, and classroom climate during early adolescence.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP4101 – Understanding Adolescent Communication Styles	This module explores how early adolescents interpret language, tone, and intent differently from younger children. Teachers learn why students may appear defensive, sarcastic, or withdrawn. Developmental influences on communication are clearly explained.		
SP4102 – Teacher Language, Tone, and Authority	Focuses on how word choice, tone of voice, and phrasing affect classroom authority. Teachers learn to communicate firmness without aggression and warmth without loss of control. Everyday classroom examples are analysed.		
SP4103 – Listening Skills and Student Voice	Examines the importance of active listening in building trust with adolescents. Teachers learn strategies to listen without interrupting, dismissing, or immediately correcting. Student voice is positioned as a tool for engagement, not loss of authority.		
SP4104 – Questioning and Dialogue in Middle School Classrooms	Explores questioning techniques that encourage thinking and discussion. Teachers learn how to manage dialogue without letting conversations derail. Respectful disagreement and clarification are emphasised.		
SP4105 – Communicating Expectations, Feedback, and Boundaries	Focuses on clearly communicating rules, academic expectations, and behavioural boundaries. Teachers learn how clarity reduces conflict and confusion. Feedback language that supports growth is introduced.		
SP4106 – Managing Difficult Conversations and Conflict	Addresses challenging conversations with students involving resistance, disrespect, or emotional escalation. Teachers learn calm, structured communication strategies that de-escalate conflict. Professional composure and consistency are prioritised.
