**Learning Objective :** This course equips middle school teachers with the knowledge and strategies to build classroom environments that are respectful, inclusive, and emotionally safe for students aged 11–14. Teachers learn how inclusion, fairness, and belonging influence behaviour, peer relationships, and learning, and how to intentionally shape classroom culture during early adolescence.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
<b>SP4301 – Understanding Classroom Culture in Middle School</b>	This module explains how classroom culture forms through daily interactions, routines, expectations, and teacher responses. Teachers learn how adolescent sensitivity to fairness and respect makes culture especially powerful at this stage. The impact of positive and negative classroom climates is explored.		
<b>SP4302 – Teaching Respect, Empathy, and Social Responsibility</b>	Focuses on how empathy and respect develop during early adolescence. Teachers learn practical strategies to model and reinforce respectful behaviour. Social responsibility is positioned as a learnable classroom value.		
<b>SP4303 – Addressing Bias, Fairness, and Equity in the Classroom</b>	Examines conscious and unconscious bias in teacher expectations and responses. Teachers learn how perceptions of unfairness quickly erode trust in adolescents. Strategies to promote equitable treatment are discussed.		
<b>SP4304 – Preventing and Responding to Bullying, Exclusion, and Harassment</b>	Explores early signs of bullying, social exclusion, and peer aggression. Teachers learn preventive classroom practices and appropriate intervention strategies. Student dignity and safety are prioritised.		
<b>SP4305 – Encouraging Student Voice, Belonging, and Participation</b>	Focuses on helping students feel seen, heard, and valued. Teachers learn how to encourage participation without forcing disclosure or performance. Belonging is linked to engagement and behaviour.		
<b>SP4306 – Sustaining an Inclusive and Respectful Classroom Culture</b>	Emphasises consistency, reflection, and long-term commitment to inclusive practices. Teachers learn how to reinforce values through routines, language, and responses. Classroom culture is presented as an ongoing process.
