Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP5201 – Understanding Career Development in Adolescence	This module explores how career interests, identity, and aspirations evolve during mid-to-late adolescence. Teachers learn why students feel confused, pressured, or unrealistic about career choices. Developmental readiness for decision-making is clearly explained.		
SP5202 – Academic Learning and Career Pathways	Focuses on the relationship between subjects, skills, and future pathways. Teachers learn how to help students see relevance between classroom learning and real-world opportunities. The dangers of narrow, marks-only thinking are examined.		
SP5203 – Skills for Future Readiness (Beyond Academics)	Explores essential skills such as critical thinking, communication, adaptability, self-management, and collaboration. Teachers learn how these skills can be developed through regular classroom practices. Future readiness is framed as skill-building, not prediction.		
SP5204 – Addressing Career Anxiety, Comparison, and Pressure	Examines stress caused by parental expectations, peer comparison, and societal definitions of success. Teachers learn how to respond to career-related anxiety sensitively. Emotional reassurance and realistic framing are emphasised.		
SP5205 – Guiding Students Without Overstepping Professional Boundaries	Focuses on the teacher's role versus that of career counsellors and parents. Teachers learn how to guide reflection, ask constructive questions, and provide exposure without giving prescriptive advice. Ethical boundaries are clarified.		
SP5206 – Creating a Classroom Culture that Supports Future Thinking	Explores how teachers can normalise exploration, flexibility, and multiple success pathways. Teachers learn how classroom language and attitudes shape student confidence about the future. Long-term perspective is encouraged.
