SP5301 – Understanding Career Development in Adolescence	This module explores the difference between managing a school and leading one. Participants examine how leadership influences culture, motivation, and outcomes. The evolving role of principals and academic leaders is discussed in contemporary education contexts.		
SP5302 – Developing a Clear and Shared School Vision	Focuses on creating a vision that reflects educational values, learner needs, and community context. Leaders learn how to move from abstract statements to meaningful direction. The importance of shared ownership of vision is emphasised.		
SP5303 – Aligning Vision with School Culture and Practice	Explores how vision must be reflected in policies, routines, teaching practices, and behaviour expectations. Leaders learn how misalignment weakens credibility. Practical strategies for embedding vision into daily school life are discussed.		
SP5304 – Communicating Vision to Staff, Students, and Parents	Focuses on effective communication of vision across stakeholders. Leaders learn how consistent messaging builds trust and clarity. Common communication breakdowns are examined.		
SP5305 – Vision-Driven Decision-Making and Leadership Consistency	Examines how vision guides decisions related to academics, discipline, staffing, and resources. Leaders learn to use vision as a decision filter. Consistency and fairness are emphasised.		
SP5306 – Reviewing, Sustaining, and Evolving School Vision	Explores how vision must be reviewed as schools grow and contexts change. Leaders learn how to assess relevance without losing core values. Long-term sustainability is prioritised.
