Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP5501 – Understanding Behaviour and Well-Being at the Institutional Level	This module explores how student behaviour and well-being are shaped by school culture, policies, and adult responses. Leaders learn why inconsistent practices escalate problems. A whole-school perspective replaces isolated incident management.		
SP5502 – Designing Clear and Fair Behaviour Policies	Focuses on creating behaviour policies that are developmentally appropriate, transparent, and enforceable. Leaders learn how unclear or punitive policies damage trust. Fairness and consistency are emphasised.		
SP5503 – Aligning Teachers Around Behaviour Expectations	Examines how staff alignment impacts discipline effectiveness. Leaders learn strategies to ensure consistent responses across classrooms and grades. Communication and training are prioritised.		
SP5504 – Student Well-Being Frameworks and Support Systems	Explores school-wide approaches to emotional, social, and psychological well-being. Leaders learn how counselling, mentoring, and pastoral systems integrate with academics. Preventive support is highlighted.		
SP5505 – Responding to Serious Behavioural and Emotional Concerns	Focuses on handling high-risk situations such as bullying, aggression, and emotional distress. Leaders learn structured response protocols and escalation pathways. Legal and ethical responsibilities are addressed.		
SP5506 – Monitoring, Reviewing, and Sustaining Discipline Systems	Explores how leaders assess the effectiveness of behaviour and well-being policies. Participants learn to use data, feedback, and reflection to improve systems. Long-term sustainability is emphasised.
