Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP5601 – Understanding Student Mental Health and Safety at the School Level	This module explores emotional, psychological, and safety-related challenges faced by students across age groups. Leaders learn how academic pressure, social dynamics, and institutional practices affect student well-being. A preventive, whole-school approach is emphasised.		
SP5602 – School Leadership Responsibilities in Child Protection	Focuses on the legal, ethical, and professional responsibilities of school leaders in child protection. Participants learn about safeguarding principles, duty of care, and mandatory reporting frameworks. Clarity of roles and accountability is emphasised.		
SP5603 – Creating Safe and Supportive School Systems	Examines how policies, procedures, and staff practices create psychological and physical safety. Leaders learn how to design reporting mechanisms, supervision structures, and safe spaces for students. System coherence is prioritised.		
SP5604 – Responding to Mental Health Crises and Safety Concerns	Focuses on leadership response to high-risk situations such as self-harm risk, abuse disclosures, severe distress, or safety threats. Participants learn structured response protocols, documentation practices, and escalation pathways. Calm, ethical leadership is emphasised.		
SP5605 – Working with Parents, Professionals, and External Agencies	Explores collaboration with parents, counsellors, mental health professionals, and child protection authorities. Leaders learn how to coordinate support while maintaining confidentiality and boundaries. Effective communication is prioritised.		
SP5606 – Building Staff Capacity and Sustainable Safeguarding Culture	Focuses on training teachers, monitoring compliance, and embedding safeguarding into school culture. Leaders learn how to prevent burnout and fear among staff while maintaining vigilance. Sustainability and accountability are emphasised.
