Participants learn how to understand behaviour as communication, use systematic observation and documentation, and design appropriate school-based interventions while maintaining ethical boundaries and referral clarity.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
<b>SP6301 – Understanding Behaviour in School Contexts</b>	This module explores behaviour as a reflection of emotional, developmental, and environmental factors. Participants learn why behaviour varies across settings and situations. A non-pathologizing, school-appropriate perspective is emphasised.		
<b>SP6302 – Common Behavioural Concerns Across School Years</b>	Focuses on frequent behavioural issues such as aggression, withdrawal, defiance, impulsivity, and attention difficulties. Participants learn how these behaviours manifest differently across age groups. Developmental explanations are prioritised.		
<b>SP6303 – Observation, Data Collection, and Functional Understanding</b>	Explores systematic observation techniques to identify behaviour patterns and triggers. Participants learn how to document behaviour objectively without labels or assumptions. Functional understanding guides intervention planning.		
<b>SP6304 – Designing School-Based Behaviour Support Strategies</b>	Focuses on interventions that can be implemented within classrooms and school routines. Participants learn how to collaborate with teachers to provide consistent support. Interventions are practical, preventive, and proportional.		
<b>SP6305 – Working with Families Around Behavioural Concerns</b>	Guides participants in communicating behavioural concerns to parents with sensitivity and clarity. Participants learn to avoid blame and alarmist language. Partnership and shared understanding are emphasised.		
<b>SP6306 – Knowing When and How to Refer</b>	Clarifies referral indicators and processes when behaviour exceeds school-level support. Participants learn how to collaborate with external professionals responsibly. Boundaries and documentation are emphasised.
