**Learning Objective :** This course equips school counsellors and well-being professionals with an understanding of how trauma affects students' behaviour, emotions, learning, and relationships within school settings. Participants learn to apply trauma-informed principles that promote safety, predictability, and support—without engaging in trauma therapy or clinical treatment.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
<b>SP6801 – Understanding Trauma and Its Impact on Students</b>	This module introduces the concept of trauma and adverse experiences in children and adolescents. Participants learn how trauma affects brain development, emotional regulation, and behaviour. Trauma responses are distinguished from intentional misconduct.		
<b>SP6802 – Recognising Trauma-Related Behaviour in Schools</b>	Focuses on behavioural, emotional, and learning patterns commonly associated with trauma exposure. Participants learn how trauma may present as aggression, withdrawal, hypervigilance, or academic difficulty. Observation without labelling is emphasised.		
<b>SP6803 – Principles of Trauma-Informed School Practice</b>	Explores core principles such as safety, trust, choice, collaboration, and empowerment. Participants learn how these principles translate into daily school interactions. Trauma-informed practice is framed as a whole-school mindset.		
<b>SP6804 – Creating Emotionally Safe and Predictable Environments</b>	Focuses on how routines, boundaries, and consistency reduce trauma-related distress. Participants learn strategies to support regulation and predictability in classrooms and counselling spaces. Emotional safety is prioritised over control.		
<b>SP6805 – Supporting Students Without Re-Traumatisation</b>	Examines how certain disciplinary or communication practices can unintentionally re-traumatise students. Participants learn supportive response strategies that reduce escalation and shame. Sensitivity and dignity are emphasised.		
<b>SP6806 – Referral, Collaboration, and Counsellor Self-Care</b>	Explores when and how to refer students for trauma-specific therapy. Participants learn how to collaborate with external professionals while maintaining boundaries. The importance of counsellor self-care and supervision is reinforced.
