Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP6901 – Understanding Peer Relationships and Social Dynamics in Schools	This module explores how friendships, group identity, power, and social status shape peer interactions. Participants learn why conflict and bullying often escalate during developmental transitions. Social dynamics are examined without moral labelling.		
SP6902 – Forms of Bullying and Peer Aggression	Focuses on physical, verbal, relational, and cyber bullying. Participants learn how subtle forms of exclusion and manipulation cause significant harm. Early identification is prioritised.		
SP6903 – Assessing Peer Conflict Versus Bullying	Explores how to differentiate normal conflict from bullying patterns. Participants learn assessment indicators such as power imbalance, repetition, and intent. Accurate identification guides appropriate intervention.		
SP6904 – School-Based Intervention Strategies	Introduces counselling and school-level strategies to address bullying and peer conflict. Participants learn individual, group, and classroom-based intervention approaches. Safety and dignity are emphasised.		
SP6905 – Supporting Victims, Perpetrators, and Bystanders	Focuses on addressing the needs of all students involved. Participants learn how to support victims; guide behaviour change in aggressors and empower bystanders. Holistic intervention is prioritised.		
SP6906 – Prevention, Policy, and Whole-School Approaches	Explores preventive programs, staff training, and policy alignment. Participants learn how to contribute to a school-wide culture of respect and accountability. Sustainability is emphasised.
