Learning Objective : This course equips school counsellors and well-being professionals with the knowledge and skills to support students with learning differences and special educational needs within school environments. Participants learn how learning challenges impact emotional well-being, behaviour, and self-esteem, and how to provide appropriate support, advocacy, and collaboration without taking on diagnostic or instructional roles.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP7001 – Understanding Learning Differences in School Contexts	This module explores common learning differences such as attention difficulties, processing challenges, language-based issues, and uneven academic development. Participants learn how these differences affect classroom experience and emotional health. A strengths-based, non-deficit perspective is emphasised.		
SP7002 – Emotional and Social Impact of Learning Difficulties	Focuses on how repeated academic struggle affects confidence, motivation, peer relationships, and self-concept. Participants learn why learning difficulties often co-occur with anxiety or withdrawal. Emotional validation and dignity are prioritised.		
SP7003 – Identifying Support Needs Through Observation and Collaboration	Explores how counsellors identify student needs using observation, teacher input, and student voice. Participants learn to recognise patterns without labelling or diagnosing. Collaborative understanding guides support planning.		
SP7004 – School-Based Support Strategies for Diverse Learners	Introduces counselling-appropriate strategies to support emotional regulation, coping, and self-advocacy. Participants learn how to help students manage frustration and academic stress. Support is framed within school boundaries.		
SP7005 – Working with Teachers, Parents, and Specialists	Focuses on coordinated support involving educators, families, and external professionals. Participants learn how to communicate learning-related concerns sensitively and clearly. Role clarity and confidentiality are emphasised.		
SP7006 – Advocacy, Inclusion, and Ethical Responsibility	Explores the counsellor's role in promoting inclusive practices and equitable treatment. Participants learn how to advocate for accommodations and emotional support without overstepping authority. Ethical responsibility and respect underpin all actions.
