SP7201 – Understanding Group Work in School Counselling	This module explores the purpose and benefits of group interventions in schools. Participants learn how group formats differ from individual counselling and when group work is appropriate. Developmental readiness and group composition are emphasised.		
SP7202 – Planning and Structuring School-Based Group Interventions	Focuses on setting goals, selecting participants, and designing session structures. Participants learn how to align group objectives with student needs and school priorities. Clear structure and boundaries are prioritised.		
SP7203 – Facilitating Groups Safely and Effectively	Explores facilitation skills such as managing participation, maintaining safety, and handling group dynamics. Participants learn how to encourage sharing without pressure. Confidentiality and respect are emphasised.		
SP7204 – Classroom-Based Well-Being and Life Skills Programs	Focuses on delivering well-being sessions within classroom settings. Participants learn how to collaborate with teachers while maintaining counselling roles. Practical program formats are discussed.		
SP7205 – Managing Challenges in Group and Classroom Interventions	Examines common challenges such as resistance, dominance, silence, or emotional escalation. Participants learn strategies to respond calmly and ethically. Flexibility and preparedness are highlighted.		
SP7206 – Evaluating Impact and Sustaining Well-Being Programs	Explores ways to assess effectiveness using feedback, observation, and simple indicators. Participants learn how to refine programs and ensure sustainability. Accountability and continuous improvement are emphasised.
