**Learning Objective :** This course provides special educators, shadow teachers, and inclusion specialists with a structured understanding of common learning differences and special educational needs encountered in school settings. Participants learn how these needs affect learning, behaviour, and participation, and how to support students effectively within classroom environments without labelling or diagnostic overreach.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions
<b>SP7601 – Understanding Special Educational Needs in Schools</b>	This module introduces the concept of SEN and its relevance in inclusive education. Participants learn how learning differences emerge in academic, behavioural, and social contexts. A non-deficit, school-based perspective is emphasised.
<b>SP7602 – Learning Disabilities and Academic Difficulties</b>	Focuses on difficulties related to reading, writing, spelling, and numeracy. Participants learn how these challenges affect classroom engagement and confidence. Practical classroom implications are discussed.
<b>SP7603 – Attention, Regulation, and Executive Function Challenges</b>	Explores difficulties related to attention control, impulse regulation, planning, and organisation. Participants learn how these challenges impact task completion and classroom behaviour. Support strategies are introduced.
<b>SP7604 – Autism Spectrum Differences in School Settings</b>	Examines communication, social understanding, sensory sensitivities, and routine needs associated with autism. Participants learn how these differences affect participation and learning. Respectful, predictable support is emphasised.
<b>SP7605 – Emotional and Behavioural Needs</b>	Focuses on emotional regulation difficulties, anxiety, and behaviour challenges. Participants learn how emotional needs often overlap with learning difficulties. Supportive, school-appropriate responses are highlighted.
<b>SP7606 – Inclusive Support Without Labels or Stigma</b>	Explores how to support diverse learners while protecting dignity and self-esteem. Participants learn to avoid over-identification and stigma. Inclusion and respect are prioritised.
