Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions
SP7701 – Understanding the Role of In-Class Support	This module clarifies how inclusive support operates within mainstream classrooms. Participants learn the difference between assisting learning and replacing instruction. Role clarity and professional boundaries are emphasised.
SP7702 – Supporting Learning Without Interrupting Teaching	Focuses on subtle, non-intrusive support techniques during lessons. Participants learn how to prompt, scaffold, and redirect students quietly. Classroom flow and student dignity are prioritised.
SP7703 – Adapting Tasks and Instructions in Real Time	Explores how to modify instructions, break tasks into steps, and clarify expectations during lessons. Participants learn how to adapt without altering curriculum goals. Responsiveness and flexibility are emphasised.
SP7704 – Supporting Attention, Engagement, and Task Completion	Examines strategies to help students stay focused and engaged during class activities. Participants learn how to use cues, routines, and visual supports effectively. Independence is encouraged alongside support.
SP7705 – Behaviour Support Within Classroom Routines	Focuses on supporting emotional regulation and positive behaviour during lessons. Participants learn how to respond to dysregulation calmly without escalating situations. Consistency with classroom rules is emphasised.
SP7706 – Gradually Reducing Support and Promoting Independence	Explores how to fade support over time to build student autonomy. Participants learn to recognise readiness for independence. Avoiding learned dependence is prioritised.
