Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions
SP7901 – Understanding the Purpose of IEPs in Inclusive Education	This module explains what IEPs are and how they support student learning and inclusion. Participants learn how IEPs guide support without lowering expectations. Role clarity in IEP implementation is emphasised.
SP7902 – Reading and Interpreting IEP Goals	Focuses on understanding academic, behavioural, social, and functional goals within IEPs. Participants learn how to interpret goals practically rather than theoretically. Alignment with classroom activities is prioritised.
SP7903 – Translating IEP Goals into Daily Support Strategies	Explores how to integrate IEP goals into classroom routines and tasks. Participants learn how to support goal progress without isolating the student. Inclusion and dignity are emphasised.
SP7904 – Monitoring Progress and Collecting Evidence	Focuses on observing, recording, and tracking progress toward IEP goals. Participants learn simple, ethical documentation practices. Data supports review and adjustment.
SP7905 – Participating in IEP Review Meetings	Examines the role of special educators in meetings with teachers, counsellors, and parents. Participants learn how to communicate observations clearly and professionally. Collaboration is prioritised.
SP7906 – Ethical Boundaries and Professional Responsibility in IEP Work	Explores confidentiality, role limits, and respectful language. Participants learn how to advocate for students while maintaining professional boundaries. Ethical practice is reinforced.
