Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP8001 – Understanding Academic Skill Gaps in Inclusive Classrooms	This module explores why students may struggle with basic academic skills despite age-appropriate instruction. Participants learn how processing differences, attention challenges, and prior learning gaps affect performance. Skill gaps are viewed as support needs rather than lack of effort.		
SP8002 – Supporting Reading Skills in School Settings	Focuses on decoding, fluency, comprehension, and reading confidence. Participants learn how to support reading during lessons through prompting, chunking, and visual aids. Classroom-appropriate strategies are emphasised.		
SP8003 – Supporting Writing Skills and Written Expression	Explores common challenges such as handwriting, spelling, sentence construction, and organising ideas. Participants learn how to scaffold writing tasks without doing the work for the student. Independence is encouraged.		
SP8004 – Supporting Numeracy and Mathematical Understanding	Focuses on number sense, basic operations, and problem-solving difficulties. Participants learn how to use concrete aids, visual supports, and step-by-step guidance. Understanding is prioritised over speed.		
SP8005 – Integrating Academic Support into Daily Classroom Activities	Examines how academic skill support can be embedded naturally into lessons and assignments. Participants learn how to support learning without drawing attention to differences. Inclusion and dignity are emphasised.		
SP8006 – Monitoring Progress and Reinforcing Academic Confidence	Explores ways to track improvement and reinforce effort and growth. Participants learn how to give feedback that builds confidence rather than dependence. Progress monitoring supports planning and collaboration.
