Participants learn how autism influences communication, social understanding, sensory processing, and learning, and how to provide structured, respectful support that promotes inclusion, participation, and independence.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP8201 – Understanding Autism Spectrum Differences in Education	This module introduces autism as a spectrum of neurodevelopmental differences rather than a single profile. Participants learn how autism affects communication, flexibility, sensory processing, and social interaction. A strengths-based and non-stereotypical understanding is emphasised.		
SP8202 – Communication and Language Support in School Settings	Focuses on verbal and non-verbal communication differences seen in autistic students. Participants learn strategies to support understanding, expression, and classroom participation. Clear language, visual supports, and predictability are prioritised.		
SP8203 – Social Understanding and Classroom Interaction	Explores challenges related to social cues, peer interaction, and group work. Participants learn how to support social participation without forcing conformity. Respectful modelling and guided practice are emphasised.		
SP8204 – Sensory Processing and Regulation Support	Examines sensory sensitivities related to sound, light, movement, and touch. Participants learn how sensory overload impacts behaviour and learning. Practical classroom-friendly sensory supports are introduced.		
SP8205 – Supporting Flexibility, Transitions, and Change	Focuses on difficulties with change, transitions, and unexpected events. Participants learn how to use visual schedules, preparation, and gradual transitions. Reducing anxiety through predictability is emphasised.		
SP8206 – Promoting Independence and Dignity in Inclusion	Explores how to support autonomy while maintaining necessary structure. Participants learn how to avoid over-support and dependency. Dignity, respect, and long-term independence are prioritised.
