**Learning Objective :** This course equips special educators, shadow teachers, and inclusion specialists with practical strategies to support students with Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity-related challenges in school environments. Participants learn how attention regulation, impulse control, and executive function difficulties affect learning and behaviour, and how to provide structured, respectful support that promotes self-regulation and academic participation.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions
<b>SP8301 – Understanding ADHD in Educational Contexts</b>	This module explains ADHD as a neurodevelopmental difference affecting attention, impulse control, and regulation. Participants learn how ADHD presents differently across students and ages. A non-pathologizing, strengths-aware perspective is emphasised.
<b>SP8302 – Attention Regulation and Classroom Engagement</b>	Focuses on difficulties related to sustaining attention, listening, and task persistence. Participants learn strategies to support engagement without constant supervision. Subtle classroom supports are prioritised.
<b>SP8303 – Managing Impulsivity and Hyperactivity</b>	Explores challenges such as impulsive responses, excessive movement, and emotional reactivity. Participants learn proactive and in-the-moment strategies that maintain classroom order and student dignity. Regulation replaces punishment.
<b>SP8304 – Executive Function Support for Students with ADHD</b>	Focuses on planning, organisation, time management, and task initiation. Participants learn how to use visual supports, routines, and structured prompts effectively. Independence-building is emphasised.
<b>SP8305 – Behaviour Support Without Over-Control</b>	Examines how excessive control can increase resistance and dependency. Participants learn how to balance structure with autonomy. Positive reinforcement and clear expectations are prioritised.
<b>SP8306 – Collaboration, Monitoring, and Ethical Practice</b>	Explores working with teachers, counsellors, and parents to provide consistent support. Participants learn documentation and progress-monitoring practices. Ethical boundaries and role clarity are reinforced.
