Participants learn how to provide academic, behavioural, and emotional support while promoting inclusion, dignity, and gradual independence, in alignment with school board guidelines and inclusive education frameworks.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions
<b>SP8801 – Understanding the Role of a Shadow Teacher in Inclusive Classrooms</b>	This module clarifies the purpose, scope, and boundaries of shadow teaching as per inclusive education guidelines. Participants learn how shadow teachers support learning without replacing the classroom teacher. Role clarity, professionalism, and collaboration are emphasised
<b>SP8802 – Supporting Students with ADHD in Classroom Settings</b>	Focuses on attention regulation, impulsivity, hyperactivity, and executive function challenges commonly seen in students with ADHD. Participants learn practical strategies to support focus, task completion, and behaviour regulation without over-control. Promoting self-regulation and independence is prioritised.
<b>SP8803 – Supporting Students with Autism Spectrum Differences</b>	Explores classroom support for communication, social understanding, sensory sensitivities, and transitions. Participants learn how to use structure, visual supports, and predictability to reduce anxiety and improve participation. Respectful, strengths-based support is emphasised.
<b>SP8804 – Supporting Students with Intellectual Disability</b>	Focuses on supporting students with intellectual disability through simplified instruction, repetition, concrete learning experiences, and routine. Participants learn how to scaffold learning while maintaining dignity and inclusion. Functional academics and adaptive skills are highlighted.
<b>SP8805 – Behaviour Support, Emotional Regulation, and Classroom Safety</b>	This module addresses emotional dysregulation, frustration, and challenging behaviour. Participants learn proactive and in-the-moment strategies to support emotional regulation without punitive practices. Safety, calm response, and consistency with school policies are prioritised.
<b>SP8806 – Promoting Independence, Inclusion, and Ethical Practice</b>	Focuses on reducing prompt dependency and gradually fading support. Participants learn how to encourage autonomy, peer interaction, and self-advocacy. Ethical boundaries, documentation, and collaboration with teachers, counsellors, and parents are emphasised.
