**Learning Objective :** This course equips educators, school counsellors, and career guidance facilitators with structured, ethical, and age-appropriate methods to guide students in making informed career choices. Participants learn how to help students understand themselves—personality traits, interests, aptitudes, learning styles, and strengths—and align these with a wide range of academic, vocational, and human-centric career pathways, while reducing anxiety and avoiding premature or imposed decisions.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions
<b>SP9101 – Understanding Career Development and Career Choices in School Education</b>	This module introduces career development as a lifelong, evolving process rather than a single decision. Participants learn how career choices emerge through awareness, exploration, and alignment over time. The role of schools in expanding choices rather than narrowing options is emphasised.
<b>SP9102 – Exploring Personality, Interests and Values</b>	Focuses on helping students understand personality traits, interests, and personal values in simple, non-labelling ways. Participants learn age-appropriate activities to explore preferences and motivations. Self-understanding is positioned as the foundation of meaningful career choices.
<b>SP9103 – Understanding Aptitude, Strengths, and Learning Styles</b>	Explores aptitudes, skill inclinations, and preferred learning styles without diagnostic testing. Participants learn how observation, reflection, and experiential activities can reveal strengths. Matching how students learn and perform with future pathways is emphasised.
<b>SP9104 – Human-Centric Skills and Professions</b>	This module focuses on careers that rely on human skills such as communication, empathy, creativity, problem-solving, leadership, and service. Participants learn how professions in education, healthcare, mental health, social services, management, entrepreneurship, and creative fields align with human-centric competencies. Skill relevance over job titles is highlighted.
<b>SP9105 – Mapping Self-Understanding to Career Pathways</b>	Explores how personality, interests, aptitude, and learning style can be meaningfully connected to career clusters and educational pathways. Participants learn structured frameworks to guide alignment conversations. Flexibility and multiple-fit options are prioritised over single “ideal” careers.
<b>SP9106 – Ethical Career Guidance, Decision-Making, and Managing Pressure</b>	Focuses on ethical boundaries, avoiding prescription, and managing parental and societal pressure. Participants learn how to support student decision-making without directing choices. Referral clarity, collaboration with parents, and emotional reassurance are emphasised.
