Learning Objective : This course equips educators, mentors, counsellors, and school professionals with a clear understanding of how children think, feel, and behave at different developmental stages. Participants learn how cognitive, emotional, social, and environmental factors shape a child’s behaviour and responses, enabling adults to interpret behaviour accurately and respond in supportive, developmentally appropriate, and non-punitive ways within educational settings.

Course Modules	Brief Course Module Descriptions		
SP9301 – Foundations of Child Psychology and Development	This module introduces the basic principles of child psychology and human development. Participants learn how thinking, emotions, and behaviour develop together rather than in isolation. Developmental variability among children is emphasised over rigid age expectations.		
SP9302 – How Children Think – Cognitive Development and Understanding	Focuses on how children process information, reason, imagine, and make sense of the world. Participants learn how thinking abilities change with age and experience. Misinterpretation of children’s thinking as defiance or carelessness is addressed.		
SP9303 – Emotional Development and Inner World of the Child	Explores how children experience, understand, and express emotions. Participants learn why children may struggle to name or regulate feelings. Emotional expression is linked to behaviour and learning readiness.		
SP9304 – Understanding Child Behaviour as Communication	This module reframes behaviour as a form of communication rather than intentional misbehaviour. Participants learn how unmet needs, stress, fear, attention-seeking, or skill gaps drive behaviour. Observation and interpretation skills are emphasised.		
SP9305 – Social Development, Relationships, and Environmental Influence	Explores how family, peers, school climate, and culture influence behaviour and self-concept. Participants learn how relationships shape confidence, cooperation, and resistance. The role of adults as emotional models is highlighted.		
SP9306 – Responding to Children with Psychological Understanding	Focuses on translating psychological understanding into everyday responses. Participants learn how to respond with empathy, clarity, boundaries, and consistency. Developmentally appropriate guidance replaces punishment-driven reactions.
